

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND EVALUATION PRINCIPLES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. International student applications for graduate programs will start on 10 July 2023 at 08:00 and will end on 21 July 2023 at 17:00.
2. Applicants must have graduated from the relevant undergraduate or graduate programs, or an equivalent undergraduate or graduate program of the Universities related to the Department to which the application will be made and must upload the application documents requested in the announcement in pdf format in the documents tab via the online application system.
3. International applicants for PhD program must have at least 55 points from YDS or YÖKDİL in a language other than their mother tongue or an equivalent score from an exam accepted by the Turkish Interuniversity Board.
4. The applications to the graduate programs are evaluated by the board of the relevant program's department/art department and finalized by the decision of the relevant institute board of directors.
5. In graduate degree applications, 50% of the undergraduate grade point average, 40% of the Turkish proficiency certificate score according to the 100-value system, and if any, 10% of the foreign language score are taken into consideration.
6. In PhD applications, 50% of the master's degree graduation grade point average, 10% of the foreign language score, 20% of the Turkish proficiency certificate score in the 100 system, 20% of the written exam score are taken into consideration. The total of the evaluations must be at least 60 for the applicant to be regarded as successful.
7. Applicants who apply to be a graduate student by certifying that they have scholarship by the Republic of Turkey or by their own country, and applicants who apply for graduate education based on international bilateral agreements to which Amasya University is a party, are accepted as students out of the quota with the opinion of the relevant program's head of the department , the decision of the board of directors of the institute and the approval of the Senate.
8. International students, unless exempted by bilateral agreements, are obliged to pay the contribution and tuition fees determined by the University Administration within the framework of the Council of Ministers Decree.
9. The applicant must have a language proficiency document/certificate (in the fields of reading, writing, listening, speaking and grammar) at least at C1 level from institutions and organizations (in Turkey or abroad) operating for the purpose of teaching Turkish to foreigners and certify it.

10. Application results are announced on the web page of the relevant institute. An acceptance letter is sent to the candidates who are entitled to enroll in the program by the relevant Institute. The documents required from the students who are entitled to register must be uploaded in pdf format in the documents tab in the online application system.
